

# Camp Rules for Participants

“Let all things be done decently and in order” (1 Cor 14:40)



The Antiochian Village- Goulburn is a great place to have fun and grow spiritually. Your safety is important. In order to have fun and keep safe there are some things that you should do. There are other things that you shouldn't do. You must abide to the below rules.

## Do

- ✓ Meet new people.
- ✓ Be polite and respectful at all times. Show good sportsmanship during games.
- ✓ Participate in all group activities and schedules unless excused by camp organisers.
- ✓ Be on the lookout for people who are new or alone and invite them to join you.
- ✓ Look out for your peers and tell your team leader/teacher/supervisor when there is a problem or concern straight away.
- ✓ Enter and move around the grounds as a sacred site whilst respecting our neighbours.
- ✓ Wear modest & appropriate clothing.
- ✓ Always wear closed shoes.
- ✓ Wear sunscreen and sunhats when outdoors.
- ✓ Pack non- aerosol deodorant, sunscreen and insect repellent.
- ✓ Bring your own sheets, pillowcases, sleeping bags, towel and toiletry.
- ✓ Participate in roll-call which will occur in the morning, evenings and before and after outings.
- ✓ Let the Child Safety Officer or supervisor know if you feel that your safety has been or could be compromised. Also let them know if someone makes you feel uncomfortable.
- ✓ Only come to camp if you are in year 7 or older (unless it is a family camp).
- ✓ Hand in your mobile phone to the camp organiser. It will be given to you for 1 hour each day.
- ✓ Leave other electronic devices at home e.g. iPad, apple watches, digital books and game consoles.
- ✓ Clean and tidy the spaces that you have used before leaving.

## Don't

- ✗ Smoke or consume alcohol or take illicit drugs.
- ✗ Take photos in the bedrooms, toilets or bathrooms.
- ✗ Visit the accommodation of the opposite gender. This means that girls cannot visit the boy's bedrooms and boys can't visit the girl's bedrooms.
- ✗ Eat in the bedrooms or outside of assigned dining areas.
- ✗ Grooming, romantic kissing and/or any sexual contact with another person is prohibited. Breach of this rule may result in instant camp dismissal and where appropriate, authorities will be notified.
- ✗ Swearing, bullying, harassment and/or aggressive behaviour to others is not tolerated. Serious breaches may lead to camp dismissal and/or police being called.
- ✗ Leave the Village without permission or supervision.
- ✗ Invite unregistered guests without the permission of the camp organisers.
- ✗ Enter the chemical storage area or the cool room in the kitchen.
- ✗ Bring weapons or knives to the Antiochian Village.
- ✗ Bring any food that may cause Allergy (especially food containing Nuts) to the Village.

Failure to abide by these rules could result in camp dismissal and in extreme cases a report to the police will be made.
